



Club Milestone Policy

PURPOSE

To acknowledge a player's achievement in reaching significant games played for football and netball at the Mandurah Mustangs. This will also assist committees (both football and netball) in preparing for milestones and budget projections on a seasonal basis. This would also run in conjunction with the Loyal Sons Program.

BACKGROUND

This document was established in 2018 as there was a need to provide clarity around the process involved in acknowledging football games milestones. As the club has grown the committee has acknowledged that netball should be included to this policy.

This policy will run alongside the Loyal Sons Program (**adopted Jan 2018, amended 2021**) that was developed to help provide an incentive to league football players that played weren't being paid.

LOYAL SONS PROGRAM

Highlighted below in red is the framework for the program. The committee also acknowledge that the program is for League football although can be adopted in future years to cater for League netball.

PROCESS

At the start of each season the Registrar (or football/netball departments) will inform the committee of the potential milestone players for the season (and roughly what round) so as a preliminary amount can be set aside in the budget.

The Registrar will liaise with the Secretary (or a committee person) ahead of time to order the banners, plaques and the milestone will be formally recognised at a home game.

7.4.4 LIFE MEMBERSHIP

7.4.4.1 The Management Committee may elect any member who has given outstanding service to the MMFC for a period of at least nine years.

7.4.4.2 The Management Committee may elect any member who has played at least 150 games for the MMFC (League games).

7.4.4.3 Any member may nominate a person to the Management Committee for consideration for Life Membership.

7.4.4.4 Life Members shall retain all the privileges of an Ordinary Member but shall not be required to pay an annual subscription.

CONDITIONS

If a player transfers in from another club and reaches a significant player milestone (i.e. 200 games or above played collectively including past clubs) the club will only offer an acknowledgement. Senior games tallies start at the first senior game of both football and netball and is also understood that junior games do not represent as senior games played.

SUMMARY

This policy helps to enhance a player's milestones and achievements that may not necessarily play league football and netball.
