



AMBULANCE ATTENDANCE PROCEDURE

In the event an ambulance is required to attend a home ground fixture the following procedures will apply.

The Mandurah Mustangs Senior Sports Trainer or duly qualified person will make the decision on whether an ambulance is required on the field or at the clubroom's dependant on the seriousness of the injury.

1. The Trainer will call **000** or appoint a committee member/team manger to do so.
2. When calling **000**, provide the following information:
 - Ambulance required at **Lakelands Park Community Sports Facility**, Banksiadale Gate, Lakelands, Western Australia 6180.
 - Ambulance access via Corner **Mandurah Road and Banksiadale Gate**, Lakelands.
3. Mandurah Mustangs **Executive Committee members (selected members)** and the **Game Day Operations Manager** hold gate access keys.
4. A volunteer will be assigned to:
 - Open the access gates onto the field (**COM A key required**), and
 - Direct the ambulance to the injured person.
5. The Trainer must remain with the injured person until ambulance officers take over care.
6. The club (preferably the Trainer) will make reasonable efforts to contact the injured person's **family or nominated contact (Mustangs person)**.
 - The next of Kin information is stored with the MMFNC Trainer and Netball Coordinator.
7. If no family member is present, the club will, where possible, assign a volunteer support staff member to accompany the injured person to hospital either via Ambulance or follow in a car.
8. Once the ambulance has departed, the access gates must be closed.
9. If not already present, the **Team Manager or Coach** must notify the Executive Committee of the incident.
