



LIFE MEMBERSHIP POLICY

This policy sets out the minimum requirements for the selection of Life Membership of the Mandurah Mustangs Football and Netball Club Inc.

It is to be awarded to deserving individual members and players who have rendered outstanding service, contributing to the Club's development and success on and off the field for a minimum of nine (9) years.

During the nomination and selection process due respect must be paid to the honour and privilege associated with the award and the fact that Life Members become role models for other Club members.

Life Membership should only be granted after careful consideration of the merits of each nominee's overall contribution to the development and functioning of the Club.

Alternatively, it is not mandatory to select a Life Member each year if a suitable candidate is not available.

Life Membership Committee:

The Life Membership Committee can be formed and consist of a minimum of four (4) and a maximum of six (6) Life Members or can be The Management Committee of the current Club Committee.

Selection Criteria in Accordance with The Mandurah Mustangs Football and Netball Club Inc. Constitution 2017 in Section 7:

The eligibility for Life Membership is considered different for a player and a volunteer:

- The Management Committee may elect any member who has given outstanding service to the MMFNC for a period of at least nine years.
- The Management Committee may elect any member who has played at least 150 games for the MMFNC (League games).
- Any member may nominate a person to the Management Committee for consideration for Life Membership.
- Life Members shall retain all the privileges of an Ordinary Member but shall not be required to pay an annual subscription.



Procedure:

Nominations for Life Membership must be made on the official Life Member Nomination Form.

The nominee must be nominated and seconded by existing financial members of the Mandurah Mustangs Football and Netball Club Inc., one of which should be an active member (as the holder of historical knowledge)

Length of membership (9 years) alone is not appropriate.

The nomination must articulate the reasons why Life Membership is considered appropriate, and where possible, specific examples of involvement within the Club should be documented.

Nomination/s should reach the Secretary no later than 4 weeks before the AGM.

Process:

All nominations are to be treated with the strictest of confidence.

Once the Secretary receives the nomination/s the Life Membership Committee will be convened to consider and scrutinise the valid nominations.

A recommendation will be prepared by the above committee to either reject or accept the nomination/s. Formal acceptance of nomination/s must be accepted by the Club Executive Committee.

The presentation of Life Membership is to be made at the Mandurah Mustangs Season opening club event the following year or when appropriate.
